

## Frequently Asked Questions in the Engineer's Office:

### 1. What is the landfill's phone number?

319-372-6140, it is listed as Great River Regional Waste Authority.

### 2. I want to put a new driveway in, what do I have to do?

You have to come into the Engineer's office at 933 Avenue H, Fort Madison and complete an Entrance Application form. It has to be signed by the landowner of where the entrance is going to be built. The landowner will need to mark the location of where the entrance is to go and the Engineer will look at the site and determine what size entrance pipe is needed. Once the permit is approved a signed copy will be mailed to you with the amount owed for the culvert and the installation charge, if there is one. Once the culvert has been paid for it will be scheduled to work on at the earliest opportunity. [Click here for Application for Permit to Construct Entrance](#)

### 3. How do we get tree sap (by-product from paper mill used as dust control on gravel roads) put on our road?

Lee County no longer applies tree sap to county roads. The material has become unavailable to us. If residents want some type of dust control they contract with private businesses to apply it for them or they may apply it themselves. If they apply it themselves they will need to complete a Dust Control Permit. Binns and Stevens, Inc. out of Oskaloosa (Phone 800-451-1744) and Whaley's Dust & Weed Control from Mount Pleasant (Phone 319-385-4521) are two companies that come into the county and apply dust control. ### 4. I want to do landscaping to the ditch in our front yard, is it o.k. to just do it?

You need to come into the Engineer's office and complete an "Application to Perform Work Within County Right of Way", and explain on it the type of work you intend to do in the county right of way. The Engineer will go to the location and evaluate the work you want to do. If the work is allowed he will approve the permit and you may proceed with the work according to the permit stipulations.
