Moved by Folluo, seconded by Fedler, to award the bid for fuel for Secondary Roads, Conservation and Sheriff to Jet Gas Corporation, Houghton, in the amount of \$69,931.25 for gasohol, \$32,335.20 for E85 and \$365,675.20 for diesel fuel. Motion carried. Other bids were received from West Central FS, Donnellson, in the amount of \$71,773.75 for Gasohol and \$254,826.00 for diesel fuel and from Agriland FS, Winterset, in the amount of \$70,232.75 for Gasohol, \$32,785.20 for E85 and \$250,426.00.
