The Lee County Board of Supervisors met on Tuesday, March 21, 2017 at 9:00 a.m., at the Lee County Correctional Center Conference Room.

Present: Ron Fedler, Gary Folluo, Don Hunold, Matt Pflug and Rick Larkin.

All votes are unanimous unless otherwise indicated.

The Board opened the meeting by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Fedler, seconded by Folluo, to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

At 9:01 a.m. Larkin opened a Public Hearing for the purpose of entering into non current debt and to purchase body cams and car cameras for the Sheriff's Office. There were no comments received prior to the hearing and no comments from those in attendance. At 9:02 a.m. it was moved by Pflug, seconded by Hunold, to close the Public Hearing. Roll call: Pflug-aye, Hunold-aye, Folluo-aye, Fedler-aye and Larkin-aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Fedler, seconded by Pflug, to table approval of Resolution #2017-78, approving non current debt. Motion carried.

Moved by Hunold, seconded by Folluo, to approve the Tuesday, March 14, 2017 Board minutes. Motion carried with Pflug abstaining.

Moved by Fedler, seconded by Pflug, to approve the payment of claims. Motion carried.

Public Input: Mary VanPelt, Montrose, asked if the Board knew anything about the Iowa Fertilizer Plant having an agreement with the Corps of Engineers to keep the river higher than normal around the Green Bay area.

Moved by Hunold, seconded by Pflug, to approve the second reading of the Minimum Wage Ordinance. Roll call: Hunold-aye, Pflug-aye, Folluo-aye, Fedler-nay and Larkin-aye. Motion carried.

Received and filed the Lee County Commission of Veteran Affairs minutes of meeting for January 31, 2017.

At 9:40 a.m., a motion was made by Hunold, seconded by Folluo, to adjourn. Motion carried. The next meeting of the Board of Supervisors will be Tuesday, March 28, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at the Newberry Senior Center in Fort Madison.
