

NEW ADDRESSES IN RURAL LEE COUNTY

The owner shall purchase an address marker from the 911 Board and install said marker in compliance with the ordinance. Permanent **rural house number markers should be placed to the right of and within twenty feet (20') of the center of the driveway as one faces the property from the road.** If two (2) houses use the same driveway, they may be placed on each side. **If located along a paved or blacktop road it should be placed forty feet (40') from the edge of the pavement of blacktop, not the rock shoulder.** If along a gravel road, place it on the right-of-way line, but not over forty feet (40') from the edge of the roadway. This would be in rural areas only. **In subdivisions, place near the driveway, possibly near a mailbox, but not to obscure the visibility of the sign.** Bottom of the sign shall be no less than three feet (3') above the ground. If for any reason this location isn't workable due to poor visibility, undesirable location, or any other reason the owner needs to request permission from the Fire Chief of said fire district to place the marker in another location. The marker needs to be visible from the road for all emergency responders.

Cost of the sign and post is \$11.25 payable when sign is picked up.
