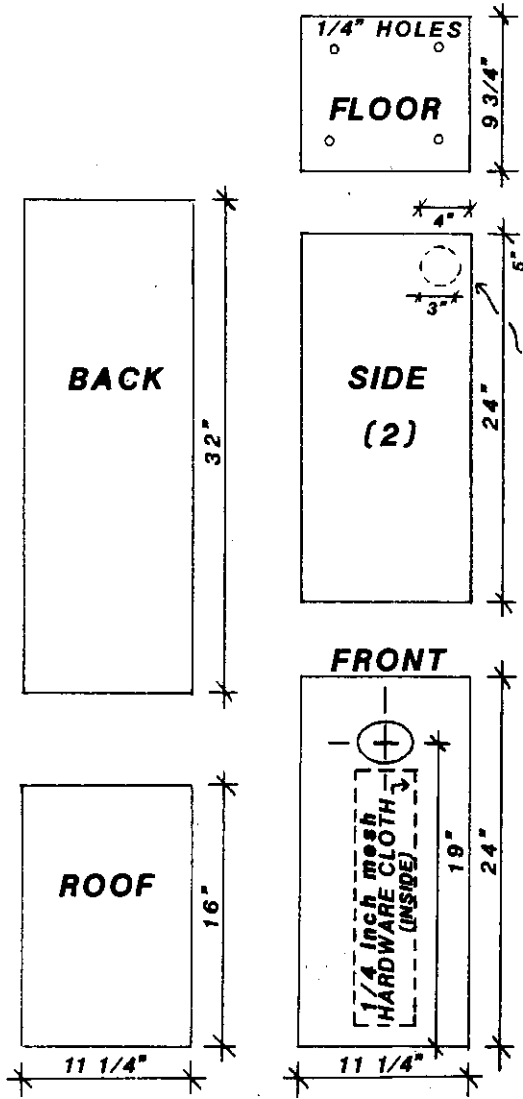
**WOOD DUCK and

3 1/2" high and 4 1/2" wide oval

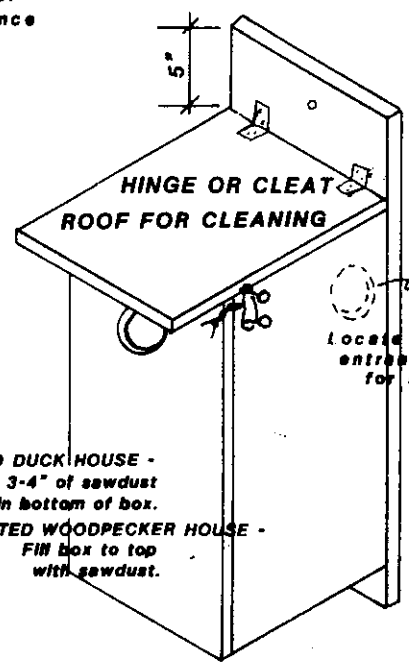
COMMON MERGANSER and RACCOON:
5" high and 9" wide oval

FOX and GRAY SQUIRREL:
3" diameter round

PILEATED WOODPECKER
4" diameter round



Optional site for squirrel box entrance



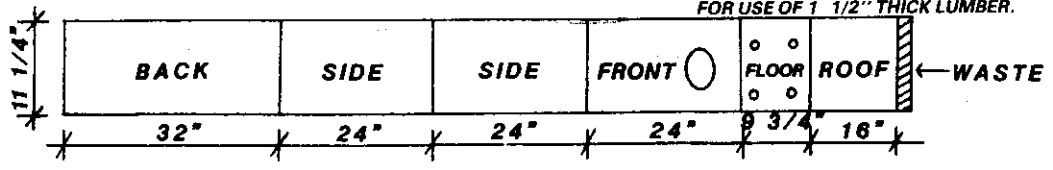
FOR WOOD DUCK HOUSE -
Place 3-4" of sawdust in bottom of box.

FOR PILEATED WOODPECKER HOUSE -
Fit box to top with sawdust.

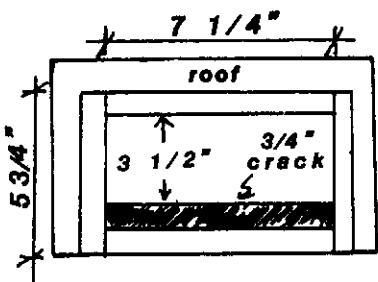
LUMBER:

ONE 1" x 12" x 12' 0"

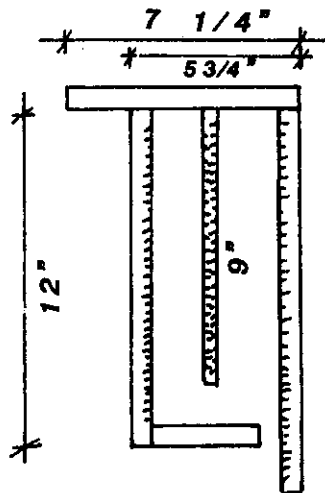
NOTE: PILEATED WOODPECKER BOX SHOULD BE CONSTRUCTED FROM ONE 2" x 12" x 12' 0" CEDAR, AND FLOOR MUST BE 8 1/4" LONG INSTEAD OF 9 3/4" FOR USE OF 1 1/2" THICK LUMBER.



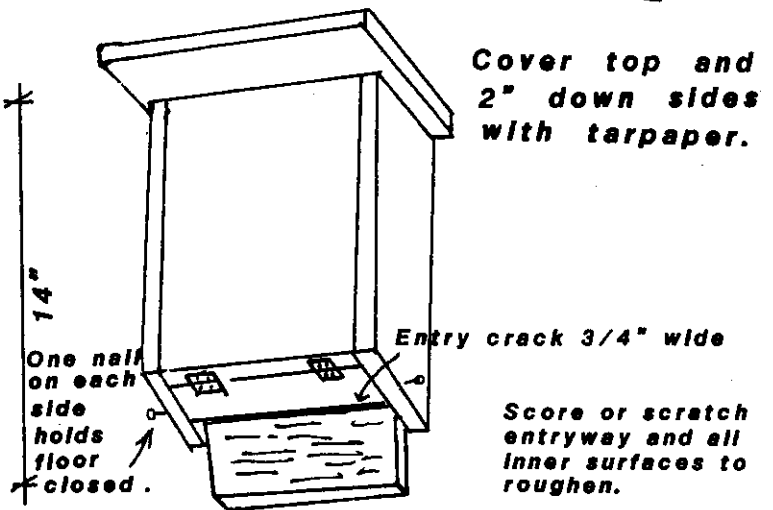
BAT HOUSE



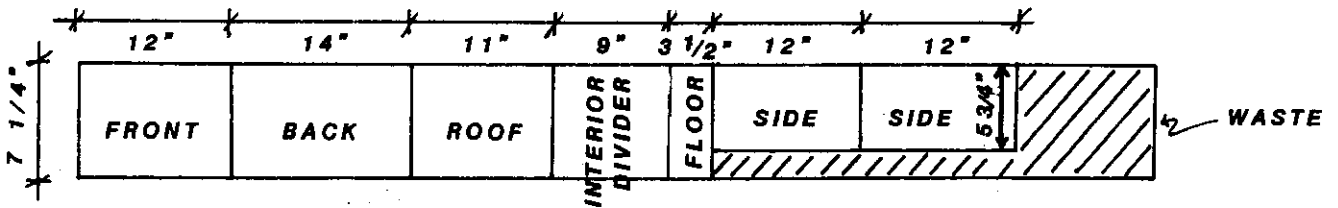
BOTTOM VIEW
