

## **Lee County Recorder's Office Begins Processing Passports in Keokuk and Announces Guidelines for Public**

The Lee County Recorder's office in Keokuk is now processing passports. The passport agent will be available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. unless otherwise announced or posted. It would be advisable for people to call the office before they come in to be sure the agent is available.

The Recorder's office is committed to helping the public adjust to the consolidation of offices and we advise anyone who purchases a boat, ATV, ORV or snowmobile to call the Recorder's office before they come to make sure they have all of the necessary paperwork. This is especially important if you are purchasing from out of state. The Iowa Department of Natural Resources oversees these registrations and the Recorder is bound to follow those regulations.
