We will meet at our normal time and location for the July meeting. We had discussed possibly meeting a day but that we will meet Tuesday to avoid confusion.

I am going to invite members of the Foundation to attend the meeting so we can have their input on our discussion about the building repairs/future. If we want to have a new building seriously considered we will need to have financial support from the foundation to pursue that option.

I'm working with Mike Short to see what if any type of resolution we would need to formally abandon camping at Indian Path Park. I will have an update for that at the meeting. Also under the Parks update I will talk about an offer from a landowner who would like the Conservation Board to consider purchasing of her property at some point in the future. This is preliminary but I wanted to have a discussion about it so we know what we can tell her going forward.

Our two other items on the agenda include considering extending the time for blind drawings. We had 9 of the 30 areas drawn on June 21. We have had one request to allow drawings for those additional areas on a first come first served basis. The other item will be a review of the bid information for the Wilson Lake shower house and dumpsites. Clint has put together the information for that and we have scheduled July 17 for the bid opening.
