I'll start by saying that there may be changes/addition to this agenda as Tuesday approaches. We are seeing new details related to the building situation come up daily so if need be I will update this as time moves ahead. For now we have items on the agenda do discuss the date for the duck blind drawing. I am moving it to June this year to try and address concerns we've heard about people not having enough time to build their blind. I will also have information on the blinds that we not removed or not completely removed.

I haven't heard back from Ernie yet regarding any county cell phone changes but I placed it on the agenda in the event we know something by next week. We also need to approve the change in our pay grid to match the changes that take place June 1st.

I'm guessing there will be additional information developing between now and Tuesday regarding a temporary location for our office. Currently we have a possibility of office space in Fort Madison behind the North County Office building that would serve our needs well (2,500 sq. ft. with phone, computer outlets, and lots of room) with one potential problem. The building is up for sale and if it should sell, we'd have to relocate again. I've contacted a mobile office company and they are looking into possibilities that we could have with that.

It's a day to day process right now so I'll up date you as I find out more.

As of today I've heard no more on the legal situation. Again if I do hear I'll follow up. Right now I've not placed anything on the agenda because that would involve a closed session with our attorney if we should want to discuss anything.

For now that's what I have. Let me know if you have any questions. I'm sure there may me new developments coming.
